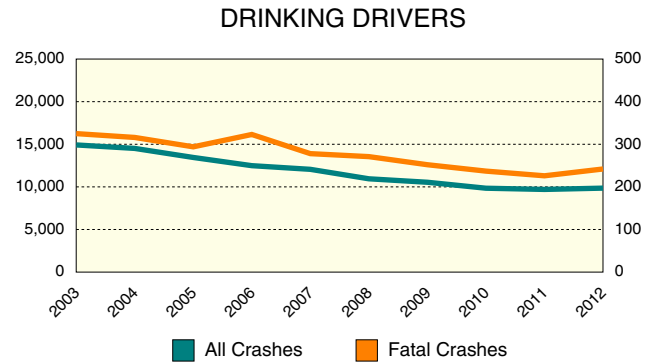


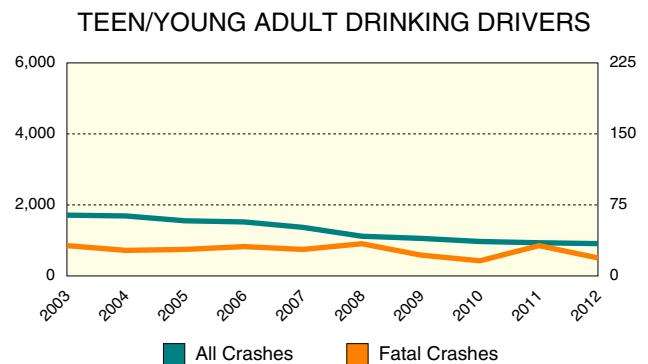

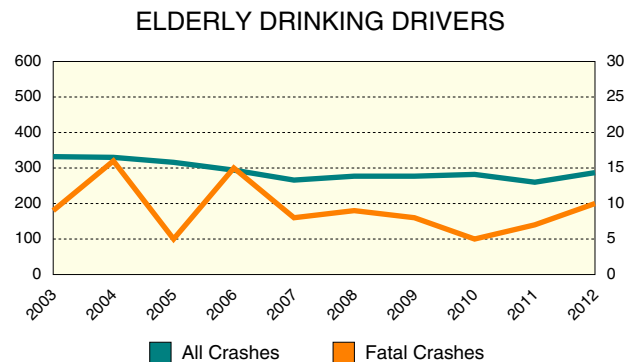
Drinking driver involvement in all crashes decreased by 34.0 percent from 2003. Drinking driver involvement in fatal crashes decreased by 25.5 percent from 2003.

Improving on the trend for all drinking drivers, the number of teen/young adult drinking drivers (age 16-20) in all crashes decreased by 46.8 percent, and their involvement in fatal crashes decreased by 40.6 percent from 2003.

The number of elderly drinking drivers (age 65-110) in all crashes decreased by 13.6 percent from 2003. However their involvement in fatal crashes was the highest since 2006.
