2012 COST OF CRASHES IN MICHIGAN

The cost estimate for Michigan crashes in 2012 is **\$ 8,436,618,800**. This estimate is based on the National Safety Council's cost estimating procedures. Average comprehensive costs are based on the following figures:

Comprehensive Costs, 2012	
Death	\$4,538,000
Incapacitating injury	\$230,000
Nonincapacitating evident injury	\$58,700
Possible injury	\$28,000
No injury	\$2,500

These cost estimates are not intended for comparisons to previous years. Deaths and injuries are calculated by number of persons. "No injury" is calculated per crash.
