2013 COST OF CRASHES IN MICHIGAN

The cost estimate for Michigan crashes in 2013 is **\$ 8,608,974,600**. This estimate is based on the National Safety Council's cost estimating procedures. Average comprehensive costs are based on the following figures:

Comprehensive Costs, 2013	
Death	\$4,628,000
Incapacitating injury	\$235,400
Nonincapacitating evident injury	\$60,000
Possible injury	\$28,600
No injury	\$2,600

These cost estimates are not intended for comparisons to previous years. Deaths and injuries are calculated by number of persons. "No injury" is calculated per crash.
