

Alcohol-related deaths averaged <b>0.78</b> per day.</p> <p>Based on the <b>2013 holiday period</b> experience, deaths averaged <b>3.81</b> per day. Alcohol-related deaths averaged <b>1.31</b> per day.</p>
