

## **MICHIGAN FARM EQUIPMENT CRASHES**

A total of 207 crashes involving farm equipment were reported on Michigan roadways during 2013. Of those crashes, two were fatal with one operator of the farm equipment killed.



## **MICHIGAN VEHICLE-TRAIN CRASHES**

A total of 58 crashes involving trains were reported in Michigan during 2013. Of those crashes, two were fatal with two persons killed, two drivers of passenger cars.



## **MICHIGAN MOTORCYCLE CRASHES**

Motorcycles were involved in 1.1 percent of all traffic crashes in Michigan in 2013. Injuries were proportionately more severe to motorcyclists than to persons in motor vehicles. The 2013 death rate for motorcyclists was 15.96 per 100 million vehicle miles traveled compared to the overall 1.00 mileage death rate per 100 million vehicle miles traveled.
