
MICHIGAN PEDESTRIAN CRASHES



In 2016, there were 2,349 pedestrians involved in motor vehicle crashes, with 165 pedestrians killed and 1,852 injured. More pedestrians within the 55-64 years of age group died than any other age group, with 29 killed (17.6%). The 25-34 age group had the greatest percentage of injuries (15.5%), and the greatest percentage of total fatalities and injuries (15.0%).
