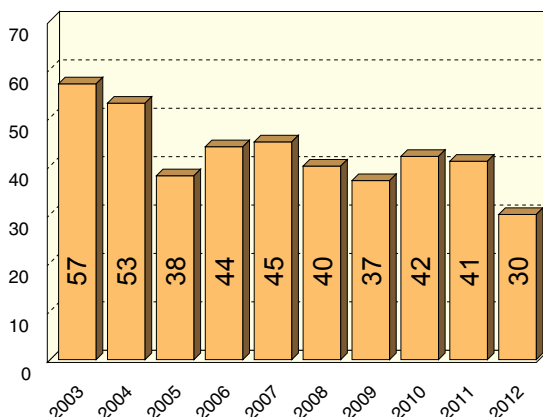




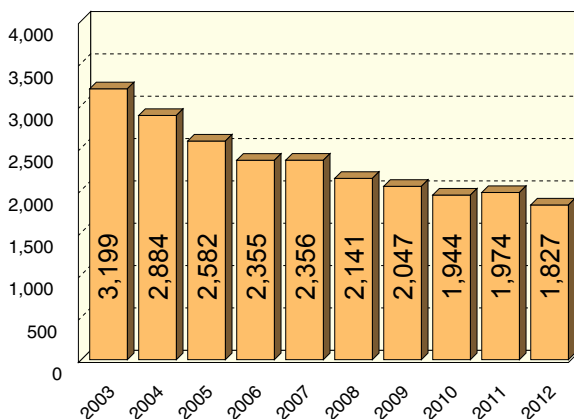

UPPER PENINSULA DEATHS



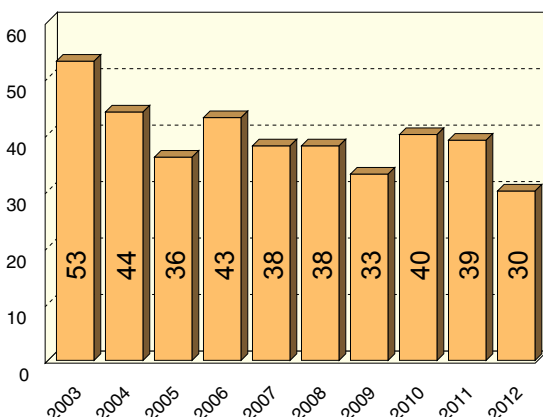
In 2012, 30 people died in motor vehicle crashes in the Upper Peninsula, a decrease of 47.4 percent from 2003.

UPPER PENINSULA INJURIES



1,827 people received nonfatal injuries in Upper Peninsula motor vehicle crashes in 2012, down 42.9 percent from 3,199 in 2003.

UPPER PENINSULA FATAL CRASHES



In 2012, there were 30 fatal crashes in the Upper Peninsula, down 43.4 percent from 53 in 2003.
