




## 10 YEAR TRENDS (continued)



Drinking driver involvement in all crashes in the Upper Peninsula decreased by 37.8 percent since 2003.



Following the trend for all drinking drivers, the number of teen/young adult drinking drivers (age 16-20) in all crashes in the Upper Peninsula decreased by 40.5 percent.



The number of elderly drinking drivers (age 65-110) in all crashes in the Upper Peninsula has decreased 25.0 percent over the 10-year period.
